Greetings from LSC

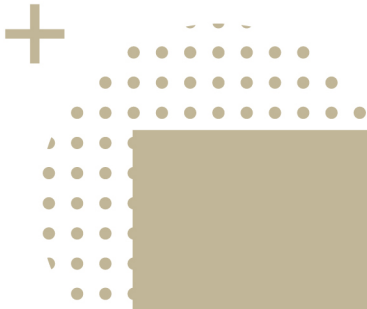

The conclave featured sessions and panel discussion that underscored the importance of ports in enhancing the Indian Economy.



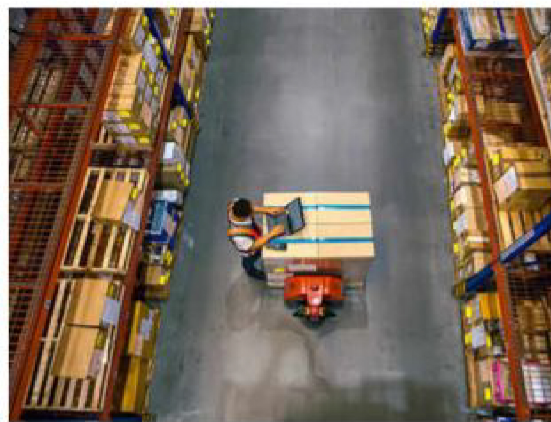

Courses in Logistics to broaden the skill base of NIOS students

Specialised courses in Logistics have been introduced for the students of classes X and XII

The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) aims to upskill its students by introducing specialised Logistics courses like Logistics Management, Supply Chain Management, Warehouse Management, Inventory Management and more. Apart from the theory, NIOS students will also be exposed to the pre-requisite practical exposure by working in the skill centres of the Logistics

Sector Skill Council (LSSC).

Speaking to *Education Times*, Saroj Sharma, chairperson, NIOS, says, "Recently, we have introduced specialised Logistics courses that are Logistics Management, Supply Chain Management, Warehouse Management and Inventory Management that are meant for secondary and senior secondary classes. LSSC has entered into a partnership with us because they do not have a school certification recognition. Apart from these Logistics courses, we already have 103 vocational courses."

The Logistics curriculum has been prepared in consultation with LSSC, which will provide the books too. Students will get hands-on training in the designated skill centres of LSSC, which comes under the ambit of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE). "We will teach the theory. In addition to this, as part of the Logistics curriculum, students would have to engage themselves in internships at the skill centres of LSSC. The Logistics curricula that has been introduced would also support our 'talking books' and 'sign language' which is meant for the 'special learners' under the inclusion policy," informs Sharma.
